- Title 1 is a funding source that provides resources for schools to assist in meeting students' needs. Assessment data is used to determine student needs and intervention services.
- Title 1 funds are used in many different ways including:
 - ✓ Additional teachers to support school-wide goals
 - ✓ Technology and student materials that support learning
 - ✓ Professional development and coaching for teachers
 - ✓ Math and literacy at many different levels that allow teachers to teach children based on their individual levels and needs
